

**NATIONAL CHINESE OWL CLUB
MEET AGREEMENT**

Below is an agreement necessary for a club to become a host of an official NCOC Meet. Our guidelines are flexible but one definite requirement is that a rebate must be paid to qualify as a master breeder point show. A minimum total of 75 birds and at least 5 exhibitors are necessary for points to be awarded toward the NCOC Master Breeder Program (unless the meet is a Mini-Meet). These terms are subject to alterations to fit a particular situation when necessary (please cross out items to be altered and add items as necessary).

AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE NCOC AND THE HOST CLUB

HOST CLUB OR MEMBER AGREES:

- To pay a \$1.00 rebate to the NCOC for every bird entered. If the normal rebate from the host club is less than \$1.00, then the host club will increase the entry fee for Chinese Owls to make up the difference so the NCOC will receive the required \$1.00 rebate.
- To furnish necessary space in the show room including a dedicated space for judging coops (minimum of twelve holes long and two levels high).
- To furnish necessary cooping, equipment, and judging coops.
- To receive, record, and classify entries based on the color classes provided by the NCOC.
- To provide the NCOC with a copy of the judging sheets at the end of the judging.
- To receive, care for, and ship out entries.
- To furnish entry blanks and show rules to the NCOC to distribute in the newsletter.
- To assist every exhibitor and visitor as necessary.

THE NATIONAL CHINESE OWL CLUB AGREES:

- To abide by the host club show rules.
- To furnish an NCOC certified judge approved by the NCOC member-in-charge.
- To accept a \$1.00 per bird rebate on all Chinese Owls entered.
- To prepare a list of special awards for Chinese Owls and file it with the show secretary.
- To supply awards to the top five places and a junior award (also Jr. Res. Champ. If at least three juniors exhibit birds) on approved District Meets.

- To distribute entry blanks and show rules to NCOC members if the host club or member-in-charge provides them.
- To promote the Chinese Owl Meet and coordinate said meet.
- To award Master Breeder points where points are warranted.
